How Hoopla Works:

With your Wayland Library card you can check out a total of 5 digital items from Hoopla per month.

All materials on Hoopla are INSTANTLY available!

With Hoopla you can enjoy:

Perks of Using Hoopla:

- Kids Mode feature for family friendly browsing
- Recommendations based on preferences and borrowing history
- Access to single-issue comics
- Download materials to device for offline use
- Easy to use from multiple digital devices including smart phones, TVs, and tablets

Setting up Hoopla

1. Visit the app store on your digital device and download the **Hoopla Digital** app.



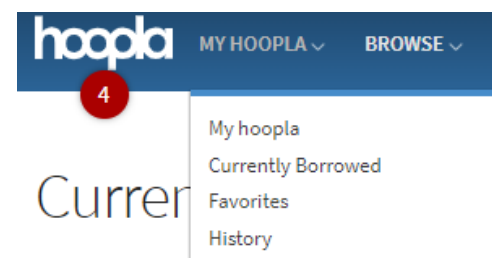
2. Enter your email and choose a password to set up your account.

3. When prompted to "Choose Your Library," enter **Wayland Free Public Library** and Agree to the terms of use.

4. Use your Wayland Library card number (listed on the back of your card) to finish setting up your account.



5. Use the **My Hoopla** tab to manage your checkouts and loan periods.

Libby



How Libby Works:

With your Wayland Library card you may have 10 digital items checked out at a time on Libby and place a total of 10 holds at a time. Items listed as Available may be checked out immediately and holds can be placed on items that are currently checked out to another patron. **The best part?** When items are due, they will automatically check back in!

With Libby you can enjoy:

- Fiction
- Non-fiction
- Graphic Novels
- Audio Books
- Magazines
- Travel Guides

Perks of Using Libby:

- No late fees
- Sample materials before checking them out
- Manage multiple library cards from one account
- Access to digital materials from other library networks
- in the state

Setting up Libby



1. Visit the app store on your digital device and download the **Libby, by OverDrive** app.

2. Confirm your library card status, then search for **Wayland Library**.

3. Enter your Wayland Library card number (listed on the back of your card) or your username.

4. Enter your PIN. If you need a PIN, set one up via the Minuteman online catalog or contact the library.

5. Use Libby's **Shelf** feature to manage loans and holds.
