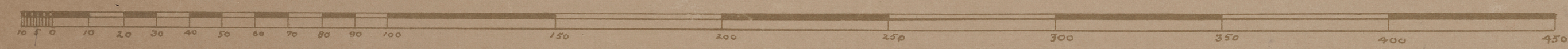


MAP OF PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

APPROXIMATE SCALE

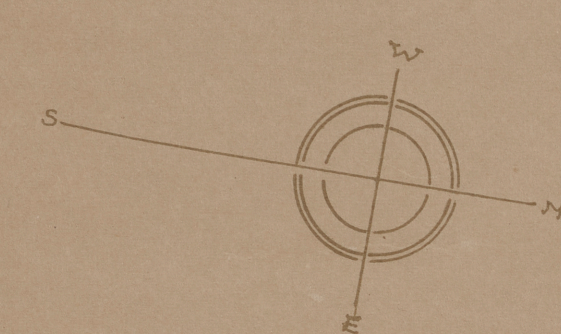
